



THE BARN



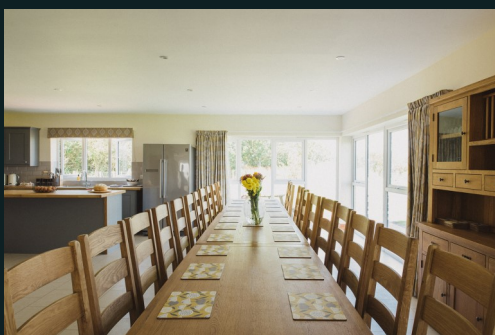

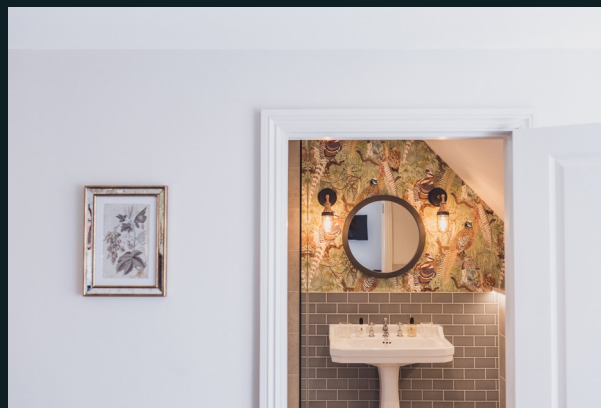
